



Analysis of Alumni feedback on Syllabus and its Transaction 2018-19: An Analysis




Interpretation:


Interpretation:

From the total respondents, 76% of the respondents rated course of study relevant to real life application as excellent, 13% of the respondents find it as very good whereas 11% rated it as good.




Interpretation:


Interpretation:
