Apart from the general subjects in degree courses (Honours and General), the college also opens job oriented/vocational courses in (i) Software Development and (ii) Sericulture with well qualified faculty members.

SUBJECTS TO BE OFFERED :

During the course of 3 years, there shall be 6 Semesters (semistor I-VI) In Semester I and II a student has to opt to either MIL (Manipuri) or General English and 3 Elective papers as shown in the "Subject Combinations"

In addition to the 3 elective papers offered, a student has to opt for additional paper (Regional Development of the North East) in Semester III and one additional paper (Environmental Studies) in Semester IV as foundation courses.

Honours is offered only in Semester V and VI. Honours subject should be one of the Elective subjects offered in the previous Semesters. A student has to opt for only one Honours subject having three papers of 100 marks each in a Semester.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE :

a) Eligibility Criteria :

- i) Arts stream : Securing minimum 40% marks in aggregate in (10+2) or equivalent examinations recognised by the Manipur University.
- ii) Science stream : Securing minimum 45% marks in aggregate in 10+2 or equivalent examinations recognised by the Manipur University.

b) Documents to be enclosed at the time of form submission :

- i) 3 (Three) copies of recently passport size photographs
- ii) 2 (Two) copies each of mark sheet of H.S.L.C. and HSSLC
- iii) 2 (Two) copies each of provisional certificate of H.S.L.C. and HSSLC.
- iv) 2 (Two) copies each of Admit card of H.S.L.C. and HSSLC
- v) Original Incom certificate of the parent/guardian from a Revenue Officer not below the rank of SDO/SDC.
- vi) Caste certificate/Trive certificate/OBC
- vii) Transfer certificate for those students coming from other institutions of Board or University.
- viii) Aadhaar Card copy
- ix) Blood Group Certificate

c) **Documents to be produced/submitted at the time of admission** :

- i) Original Income Certificate issued by competent authority (for students belonging to low income group)
- ii) Original documents
- **N.B.**: 1.Students who passed the qualifying examination form the Board/Council other than the Council of Higher Secondary Education, Manipur, shall have to submit "Migration Certificate" at the time of admission or within one month from the date of admission.
 - 2.Documents once submitted along with the application form shall not be returned.
 - 3.Incomplete application form will be rejected.
 - 4. The procurement of Admission Form does not guarantee admission.

5.If any forgery in the documents of the students is detected after admission, the Admission Committee has the right to cancel such admission at any stage.

ATTENDANCE REQUIREMENT:

Students should attend classes, tutorials and practicals regularly. The minimum attendance of a student must be not less than 75% of the lectures delivered, including practicals. Students whose attendance is below 75% will be treated as Non-collegiate as per the University Ordinance and they will not be allowed to sit in the semester end examination of the current session.

INCENTIVES :

There will be complete exemption of Admission Fee (Free admission) in the 3rd and 5th semester if a students' attendance in the 2nd, 3rd and 4th Semester is and above 80%.

CODE OF CONDUCT (Campus rules for students)

In general, students should behave in such a way so as to maintain high standards of behavior and disciplines as prescribed in the Campus Rules of the college and violation of any of such rules may lead to disciplinary action as per the regulation of the college ethics committee. Therefore the students are required;

- 1. To strictly observe discipline in the college campus.
- 2. To pay respect to the teachers and other staffs.
- 3. To possess valid identity card issued by the college.
- 4. To wear college uniform, (wearing slippers and open shirts are not allowed to attend class).
- 5. To switch o ffmobile phones in the class room.
- 7. To make the entire campus an intoxication free zone, smoking, chewing pan and use of any other intoxicating items are stickily prohibited.
- 8. Not to loiter on the verandah.
- 9. Not to indulge in eve-teasing, immoral activities including use and chatting with cell phone inside college campus.
- 10. Not to indulge in anti-social, anti-national and communal activities.
- 11. Not to sit on the parked vehicles.
- 12. Not to damage any college properly, activities relating to destruction of college property will be viewed seriously and punishable.

Manipur University, Canchipur, Imphal ORDINANCE (Reproduction of Relevent Parts)

(Approved by the Academic Council under resolution No. 3/Spl/14/06/2010)

- 6.1 A student who has studied a regular course of study for a semester in an affiliated or permitted college may be admitted to the end-Semester examination provided the student has attended not less than 75% of the lecturer delivered, including practicals.
- 6.2 A student who has enrolled himself/herself in more than one college/institute simulteniously shall not be admitted into the end Semester examinations.
- 7. Promotion :
- 7.1 A student who has passed all the papers of the semester examination will be promoted to the next higher semester.
- 7.2 A student who has failed in one or two papers in a semester may also be promoted to the next higher Semester provided that in no case a student will be promoted to the next higher semester if he/she has more than four failed papers at a time."
- 10. Admission of the unsuccessful and absent candidates : A student who has admitted into a semester examination but could not pass/could not be promoted to the next available regular examination as a casual student on payment of necessary prescribed fee.
- 11. Notwithstanding anything contained in the above clauses a student must complete the course within a continuous span of ten semesters from his/her initial admission.

MANIPUR UNIVERSITY CANCHIPUR, IMPHAL

Office Order No. 570 Dated the 23rd August, 2011

No. MU/2-6/2006 : The Academic Council under Resolution No. 12 of its meeting held on 17/08/2011 has approved the following amendments of the sub-clause 7.2 of clause 7 'Promotion' and Sub-Clause 9.1 of Clause 9 'Classification and Class and Grade' of the BA/B.Sc./B.Com Ordinance, 2010 as under

7.1 (i) A student who has appeared at the first semester examination may be allowed to attend Second Semester classes immediately after he/she has appeared at the first semester examination and allow to appear Second Semester examination irrespective of any number of back papers one has.

7.2 (ii) A student who has appeared at the second semester examination may be allowed to attend third semester classes immediately after he/she has appeared at the second semester examination and allow to appear third semester examination.

7.2 (iii) A student who has appeared at the Third semester examination may be allowed to attend Fourth semester classes immediately after he/she has appeared at the Third semester examination and will be allowed to appear fourth semester examination if he/she has a maximum of four back papers only in first second and third semester examinations taken together.

7.2 (iv) A student who has appeared at the fourth semester examination may be allowed to attend Fifth semester classses immediately after he/she has appeared at the fourth semester examination and allow to appear Fifth semester examination. 7.2 (v) A student who has appeared at the Fifth semester examination may be allowed to attend Sixth semester classes immediately after he/she has appeared at the fifth semester examination and will be allowd to appear at Sixth semester examination if he/she has a maximum of four back papers only in third fourth and Fifth semester examinations taken together.

9.1 A student who has passed all the six semesters in regular attempt shall be placed in the class "Honours with Distinction" if he/she secured at least 85% marks in aggregate in Honours subject in all the semesters.
